

Ambassador Ilan Mor

Prior to his appointment as Ambassador of the State of Israel to the **Republic of Croatia**, Ambassador Ilan Mor served as Senior Political Advisor to Minister of Justice Ayelet Shaked **in Jerusalem**, **Israel** between 2016 and 2018.

Since joining the Israeli Diplomatic Service in 1983 and throughout his career, Ambassador Mor has held a wide variety of diplomatic posts, with particular focus on geostrategic issues at home and abroad:

Ambassador Mor served as Ambassador of the State of Israel to **Hungary** between 2011 and 2016.

Prior to his appointment as Ambassador to Hungary, Ambassador Mor served as Senior Foreign Policy Advisor to the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) Planning Branch, Strategic Division, in **Tel Aviv, Israel** from 2009 to 2011.

Between 2004 and 2009 he served as Minister, Deputy Chief of Mission (DCM) at the Embassy of Israel in **Berlin, Federal Republic of Germany.**

From 2002 to 2004 Ambassador Mor was Director of the Department for the Prevention of the Proliferation of WMD and Terrorism, Strategic Division at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in **Jerusalem, Israel.**

From 1998 to 2002 he was a Minister, Deputy Chief of Mission (DCM) at the Embassy of the State of Israel in **Beijing, PR China**.

Between 1996 and 1998 Ambassador Mor served as a Counsellor at the Information Department of Ministry of Foreign Affairs in **Jerusalem**, Israel.

From 1992 to 1996 he was the Head of the Information Department and Spokesman at the Embassy of Israel in **Bonn, Federal Republic of Germany.**

Between 1990 and 1992 he was First Secretary at the Division for International Organizations in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in **Jerusalem**, Israel.

From 1988 to 1990 he served as Consul for Press and Information at the Consulate-General of the State of Israel in **Los Angeles, USA.**

Between 1986 and 1988 he served as Second Secretary at the Embassy of the State of Israel in **Monrovia, Republic of Liberia.**

Ambassador Mor holds a B.A. in Political Science and Working Relations and an M.A. in International Relations both from the **University of Tel Aviv, Israel**.

He speaks Hebrew, English and German fluently. He is married to **Ms. Ora Mor** and has a daughter and a son, and two wonderful grandchildren.
