



Call for participation: SEA-EU Science Show for early-career researchers, 29 September 2023 in Kiel

We are very pleased to be able to host again the **SEA-EU Science Show** as part of the European Researchers Night in Kiel and offer **six scholarships to enthusiastic early-career researchers from the SEA-EU Alliance** to be a part of this truly European experience.

WHO? We are looking for PhD and PostDoc researchers (max. two years after doctorate) from any discipline who are currently studying or employed at one of the SEA-EU Universities.

WHEN? Arrival must be on Tuesday, 26 September and departure on Saturday, 30 September.

WHAT? The scholarship includes

- 2-3 individual preparation sessions with professional coaches during August and September (online)
- a 2-day science communication training workshop from 27-28 September in Kiel (in person)
- a 10-minute public presentation of your research at the European Researchers Night in Kiel on 29 September (in person), and
- a feedback session in October (online)

Participation in all sessions is mandatory when accepting the scholarship. All sessions are held in English.

HOW MUCH? The scholarship will cover

- Transportation costs, incl. flights, trains and airport transfers (only second class/economy travel, no taxis)
- Accommodation costs of up to EUR 80/night
- A daily meals allowance of EUR 14-28 /day according to the [Federal Travel Expenses Act](#)

HOW? Applications consisting of a short CV and abstract of your research can be submitted no later than 7 July to EUoffice@uv.uni-kiel.de. In case of more than six applications we will have an internal selection process. In order to achieve the greatest possible diversity, a maximum of two researchers from the same university can be selected.
