



Fighting educational poverty by guaranteeing access to non-formal and inclusive education for children and adolescents and providing vocational training for new-adult people and NEETs.





Promoting social inclusion by providing vulnerable families with material support and social assistance and welcoming asylum seekers and refugees by accompanying them towards social and economic autonomy.
