Tuesday is all about mental health and well-being, with workshops and discussions led by experts from the university’s counseling and student services.

Wednesday offers practical insights into student health, learning spaces, and career support for international students, plus a guided campus tour through our green and peaceful environment. On

Thursday, participants explore internationalization under the theme “FIT – Forging International Talents” with hands-on workshops and a cultural evening including a guided tour of Siegen’s old town, castle, and the Rubens Museum.
